Foreword

Thank you for purchasing the Washburn WA20 acoustic guitar amplifier. Read this manual thoroughly prior to using your amplifier in order to get the most out of the functions available. Ensure that this manual is also stored in a safe place.

Features

The WA20 amplifier provides 10W of output and utilizes a 6.5-inch driver. The preamp is equipped with a vocal guitar input. The EQ employs bass, middle, and treble controls to produce a wide range of sounds. Moreover, the speed of the chorus effect (turned ON/OFF by switch) can be controlled.

Precautions During Use

- Do not subject the amplifier to shocks by dropping or rough handling.
- Install the amplifier in a stable location. The amplifier will sound differently depending on the method, location, or venue of installation.
- Ensure that the power supply is switched OFF when the amplifier is not in use. Also remove the power cable from the power supply socket when the amplifier is not to be used for an extended period of time.
- Do not use or store the amplifier in locations where it is subject to direct sunlight or in environments that experience dramatic fluctuations in temperature and humidity levels.

- Reduce the volume to "0" or switch OFF the power supply when connecting the guitar shielded cable, the microphone cable, and cables connected to external units, such as the effects. Note that the noise generated when plugs are inserted or removed may cause severe damage to equipment.
